## SNOW REMOVAL TIPS HOA Snow Service - Plowing

1

\*Make sure all items are out of the street so plowing is easy and less messy.

2

\*Brightview will plow the designated streets every 1-2" of snowfall, then leave the site and then return again after another 1-2" has accumulated.

3

Our goal is to simply keep drive lanes passable for Emergency vehicles during the snowfall. Once the storm ends - we will make a final push to clean up and then apply chemicals as directed for ice control.

When you clean off your car, driveway pad & sidewalks, throw the snow in the yard - not in the street.

Many times people throw snow in the street after we finish plowing and then the street becomes a compacted mess and is hard to clean up, refreezes, etc.
